Main Responsibilities:

- Create a comprehensive communications plan
- Review analytics to monitor and evaluate reach and impact
- Lead the management and execution of cross platform social media strategy and planning
- Plan and implement all communication materials, including social media, website content management, e-mail marketing, and other materials
- Create and edit graphics for print, website, and social media
- On-site support at HCT's Community Connect events in May and July, and/or our annual AGM (June) and Peer-to-Peer Fundraiser (Aug)
- Work collaboratively with other members of the team, providing assistance as needed
- Actively participate in team meetings and organization-wide activities

Qualifications:

- Excellent written and verbal communication in English.
- Proficient in computer applications (e.g., Microsoft Office Suite and/or Google Suite), mobile technology (e.g., Canva, Later, Squarespace) and online/cloud-based platforms (e.g., CRM)
- Self-motivated individual, with the ability to identify new opportunities and areas of improvement
- Effectively able to manage multiple projects on your own, demonstrating ability to prioritize responsibilities and meet deadlines
- Detail-oriented and organized in a fast-paced environment
- Work collaboratively with team members in a remote environment
- Graphic design experience, photography and video editing experience are assets
- Experience with, knowledge of and interest in homelessness issues is preferred.

Requirements:

- Between 15 and 30 years of age on the first day of employment
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred for the duration of employment. International students are not eligible.
- A valid social insurance number and legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Able to work continuously for 14 weeks between May 6 and Aug 23, 2024.

Homeless Connect Toronto, which is founded and operated by individuals self-reporting from underrepresented groups, is looking to hire youth from underrepresented groups or with disabilities as our Communications Officer for the summer.

The youth will work with a team to be responsible for the development of a communications plan, lead the management and execution of cross platform social media strategy, plan all communication materials for social media and website, develop a resource guide for homelessness help supports, and work collaboratively with team members to ensure the success of our Community Connect events. The youth will be provided access and training to a wide variety of digital technology, including Microsoft Suite, Google Suite, CRM system, Adobe programs, etc.

Youth will also be provided with opportunities to directly support individuals impacted by homelessness on-site at our Community Connect events throughout the summer.

Supervision will include support to develop initiative-taking, communication, organizational and collaborative skills. The youth will also receive one-on-one mentoring with the Executive Director throughout the summer.
